Australia Primary Immunodeficiency Patient Support (AusPIPS Inc)	Australia Primary Immunodeficiency Patient Support (AusPIPS Inc) advocates for and supports individuals with primary immunodeficiency (PID), and related chronic secondary conditions, and their carers. AusPIPS collaborates with stakeholders to drive meaningful improvements in the lives of PID patients across Australia. Support was provided to AusPIPS for the development of a series of webinars to address SCIg funding access challenges, educate patients on sepsis risk, and improve understanding of immunoglobulin therapies to support informed decision-making. Additional initiatives included a patient brochure on SCIg benefits and advocacy training to strengthen patient representation. The value of this support was \$10,000.	\$10,000
Immune Deficiency Foundation Australia (IDFA)	The Immune Deficiencies Foundation Australia (IDFA) is a not-for-profit organisation that raises awareness, provides education and advocates for people with Primary (Genetic) and Secondary (due to chemotherapy and other treatments/or autoimmune illness) immune deficiencies. Support was provided for the IDFA national conference and a webinar series, both of which provided education to patients and caregivers, on primary and secondary immunodeficiencies. HAE Australasia	HAE Australasia is a not for profit patient advocacy organisation, dedicated to providing support to Australian and New Zealand Hereditary Angioedema (HAE) patients and their families, as well as raising awareness of HAE resulting from C1-inhibitor deficiency. Support was provided for the HAE Australasia 2025 Patient & Carer's Conference in New Zealand which delivered HAE education for patients to improve the quality use of medicines and patient outcomes. The value of the support was \$14,000.	\$14,000
Australasian Society of Clinical Immunology and Allergy (ASCIA)	Australasian Society of Clinical Immunology and Allergy (ASCIA) is the peak professional body of clinical immunology and allergy in Australia and New Zealand. ASCIA promotes and advances the study and knowledge of allergy and other immune diseases. Support was provided to assist ASCIA with Immunodeficiency Strategy initiatives 2025-2026, which focuses on inborn errors in immunity (IEI), including Hereditary Angioedema (HAE) and other primary immunodeficiency (PID) disorders. CSL Behring also supported the development of a new "ASCIA Understanding IEI and Immunology" education resource and the updating of the ASCIA HAE Position Paper and Management Plan, and development of the new ASCIA HAE Clinical Care standard.
